

Intent to Contract for Acute Inpatient Emergency Room Psychiatric Crisis Evaluations

Lane County, through the Department of Health and Human Services, has determined through a request for Letters of Interest (LOI) that PeaceHealth Oregon Region is a sole source to provide acute inpatient emergency room psychiatric crisis evaluations in the amount of \$223,168 for staff costs and \$45,000 in client reimbursement costs. The contract period will be July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011 with two one-year extensions possible based upon contractor performance and availability of funding.

Therefore, Lane County hereby provides notice of intent to award this contract.

Appeal of intent to award contracts

If you are a person or entity whose interest are adversely by these awards you may deliver a written protest to the award(s) per Lane Manual 21.111 Sole Source. Marcia Johnson, Program Services Coordinator 2, must receive the written protest by July 30, 2011 at 3:00 p.m. The decision over whether to grant the award(s) will be made by the Board of County Commissioners following a public meeting at which the written record of the procurements is reviewed as well as the written protest and any other testimony provided.

Written Protest

The written protest shall include:

1. A detailed statement of the legal and factual grounds for the protest based upon findings that support that the services are available from more than one source.
2. A description of the resulting harm; and,
3. A description of the relief requested.
