**DETAILS:**

On 06-24-10, at approximately 3:42 P.M., Lane County Sheriff's deputies were responding to a report of a suspicious vehicle, identified as a red Chevy Cobalt, or similar vehicle, in the area of Territorial Hwy and Wolf Creek Rd. It was reported that the occupants of the vehicle, 2 males and 1 female, had smashed open a safe with a brick and were leaving the scene in the Chevy.

A Lane County Sheriff's deputy located the vehicle travelling on Crow Rd heading towards Eugene. The deputy followed the vehicle until a Eugene Police Officer caught up with them at Beltline Hwy and Delta Hwy. A traffic stop of the Chevy was initiated on Delta Hwy, south bound, at which point the Chevy sped away. The Eugene Police Officer was able to use a PIT maneuver to stop the vehicle, which ended the pursuit on Delta Hwy at the Valley River exit.

The two male occupants were taken into custody and lodged at the Serbu Youth Facility. The female occupant was transported to Riverbend Hospital, for non-life threatening injuries, and later lodged at the Serbu Youth Facility. All three youths were lodged on warrants with additional criminal charges pending.
