



The Lane County Department of Youth Services (DYS) is in the process of developing a grant application for Federal Fiscal Year 2010, through the U.S. Department of Justice/Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention (OJJDP), through its Second Chance Act Juvenile Mentoring Initiative. Major activities to be supported under this grant application include increasing community capacity to provide mentoring and transitional services to juvenile offenders, ages 17 & younger, who are transitioning from incarceration or detention to the community. If successful in this funding application, this grant development effort may result in sub-contract awards to eligible community agencies whose core function is to provide mentoring services to this population. Community agencies who are currently partnering with Lane County DYS on this potential grant application need not respond to this ad.
